There have been struggles but in the midst of the struggle, spending time with the Stepping Stones young moms has been a bright spot and such a blessing. Recently an organization called Sisterhood YXE put on a special city wide baby shower for moms who are pregnant or have a baby under 1 year and who would not have the opportunity to have a baby shower of their own. Three of my young moms qualified for this event and I am so thankful to have been with them. We did not know what to expect when we walked in but we were blown away by how beautifully the Friendship Inn was decorated. They went above and beyond with with balloons, streamers, teddy bears, classy table linens and a photo booth. One of the young moms commented multiple times about how she did not expect it to look that nice in there. On the tables there were luxury gift baskets with things like organic chocolate and organic moisturizing balm and I thought to myself "wow, this is very extravagant and maybe the wrong crowd for this kind of thing." Then I took a moment and realized I was wrong. This is EXACTLY what my young moms and the other women who were there needed; someone to show them that they are loved and worthy of extravagant things. Is that not what God wants for us? For us to know that we are worthy of his extravagant love?!

The luxurious afternoon continued with a supper provided by Refuge Coffee and Baking from Warman. We could not identify all the things on the sandwiches but they were so delicious and the young moms all commented on parts of it that they did not know what it was, but they loved it. At the end of the event the volunteers walked out with multiple bags and boxes and a diaper bag for each mom. I watched with glee as my moms opened all these gifts and with each new thing to open they were more and more excited. I estimate that they walked out of there with \$400 worth of gifts and a \$100 Babies R Us gift card. I had squeezed two moms and their kids and car seats into my car and did not think there was anyway all those gifts would fit in my trunk. I am certain it was a miracle from God that all the gifts fit. The moms said over and over in the car that they could not believe they got to be at that event.
